### PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Progress reports will be coming home on November 9th. Student led conferences will take place during the week of November 12-16. Please ensure you have booked a time to attend a student led conference with your child and their teacher. This is a great opportunity to review your child's progress to date.

### Setting Goals is an Essential Life Skill

- Knowing how to set reasonable goals and striving for them is an important life skill.
- Encourage your child to think about what they want to accomplish, i.e., is it a short term and/ or long term goal,
- ⇒ For example: I will improve my reading fluency by reading for 30 minutes each night.
- $\Rightarrow$  I will bring 2 healthy snacks to school each day for nutrition breaks.
- ⇒ I will participate in class by contributing ideas at least twice a day
- Short term: Set a deadline. Short-term goals are the most attainable and realistic when it comes to goal setting.
- A good "short term" deadline could range from a couple of weeks up to a month
- Once you have determined a goal with your child, set a plan, "how will they reach their goal?"

### Stress Response: What is it?

Stress is not new. Thousands of years ago, humans were hunter-gatherers. Stress was a trigger for adrenalin; it made people faster, stronger, more alert. We're not hunting or running away from predators much today. But the stress response system or the "fight or flight response" still kicks in when we're rushing around. If daily life is filled with stress triggers, it can harm your health – and create tension in the family.

When parents can stop, take a breath and re-think a stressor or problem, kids will also learn to stop and think and become creative problem-solvers rather than meet a problem with a "tiger fighting" response.
